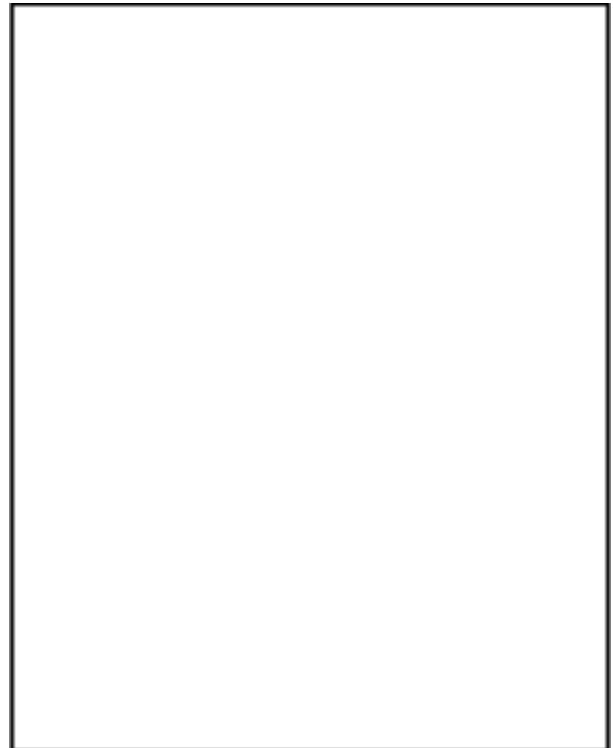


2023 SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION
