The Durfee Family Scholarship provides financial assistance to deserving young people who, despite personal challenges, are striving to attend institutions of higher learning.

Five \$2,000.00 scholarships will be awarded to university or college-bound students in South Bay, Harbor and Long Beach school districts.

Requirements

Applicants must meet the following criteria:

1. Must be accepted into an accredited university or college. Preference will be given to students attending colleges, community colleges or technical schools within the state of California.
2. Must be a graduating high school senior from a school within the Volunteer Center's service area (South Bay, Harbor, Long Beach).
3. Must demonstrate a willingness to make a positive contribution to their community through volunteerism and/or acts of empathy and compassion for those in need.

- A brief essay describing your volunteer or work experience and how it has positively impacted you and your community (**Send as an attachment when you email this application.**)
- A brief personal essay, including career goals, and any adverse personal or family circumstances you have had to overcome while pursuing those goals. (**Send as an attachment when you email this application.**)
- An official high school transcript (Please provide a link for us to access your transcript electronically.) _____
- One letter of recommendation (cannot be a relative of the applicant) (**Send as an attachment when you email this application.**)
